

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



ELIGIBILITY

DCG seniors entering a trade program, community college, 4-year university or private college independent of any financial or other circumstance

THE PROCESS

- Scholarship applications will be open for completion from March 1-31.
- Scholarship applications will be completed through a form published to the dcgeducationfoundation.org website.
- Students will have access to scholarship sponsor requirements to verify eligibility.

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

- Compile a list of your activities, awards, grades, and other relevant information.



TIMELINE

February

- Senior meeting during AO to communicate the process and expectations

March

- Scholarship applications open are live; applications close March 31

April

- Evaluations and selections made by scholarship sponsors and DCGEF

May

- Wednesday, May 21 - Senior Awards Night (details to come)

June

- Recipients complete payment request form

July 2025

- DCGEF distributes awarded funds to respective schools



TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Don't Procrastinate

- Review the application requirements and gather all relevant information.
- Give yourself plenty of time to ensure accuracy and completeness.

Have a Plan for Writing Essays

- Start with an outline to align responses with the essay question.
- Be clear. Be concise. Be specific.
- Write your essay response in a draft document and copy to the application once finalized to reduce typing errors.
- Craft your essay responses thoughtfully and with consideration.
- Re-read your essay response and make sure you answered the question asked.

Check Your Work

- Proofread everything (Grammarly is your friend!)
- Have someone else review your responses for accuracy, cohesiveness and alignment with the question.
